4. **PHOTOGRAPH**: A recent passport size self attested photograph should be affixed on the right hand top corner of the original application.
5. **COPIES OF CERTIFICATES**: Candidates should submit along with their application attested copies (SINGLE copy only) of marksheets/certificates of:  
a) Educational qualification and technical qualification    b) Date of birth  
c) Their Claim that they belong to SC/ST/PH/EXM/OBC/ Sportsman  
d) Experience specifically stating the kind of work done.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR THE INFORMATION OF APPLICANTS**

1. **AGE LIMIT as on 28.2.2011**  
For Post Code I : Between 18 and 35 Years  
For Post Code II to VII : Between 18 and 27 Years  
(Relaxation in upper age limit will be allowed in the case of candidates with longer experience and outstanding merits.)

2. AGE RELAXATION in addition to the above:
  - a) **SC/ST** : 5 years.
  - b) **OBC** : 3 years
  - c) **Ex-serviceman** : After deducting the period of armed force service from the actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post of service for which he seeks appointment by more than three years.
  - d) **Physically handicapped persons** : The upper age limit relaxable upto ten years in the case of persons with disabilities like Low vision, Hearing Impairment and orthopedically handicapped
  - e) **Govt. Servants** : In accordance with orders of the Central Govt.
3. Relaxation in the upper age limit of 5 yrs shall be admissible to persons who had ordinarily been domiciled in Kashmir division of the state of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1980 to 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 1989 provided that the relaxation in the upper age limit for appearing at any examination shall be subject to the Max number of chances permissible under the relevant rules.

**Certificate regarding proof of residence**- Any person intending to avail of this relaxation of age limit admissible under rule 3 shall submit a certificate from:

  - a) the district magistrate in the Kashmir division within those jurisdiction he had ordinarily resided; or
  - (b) any other authority designated in this behalf by the government of Jammu & Kashmir to the effect that he had ordinarily been domiciled in the Kashmir division of the state of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 1980 to the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 1989
4. Interview will be held at RRCAT Indore. To & fro Sleeper Class rail fare by shortest route will be reimbursed to the candidates called for interview from out-stations for the post code I & II on production of rail/bus tickets. However, SC/ST candidates called for interview from out-stations for the post code II to V are eligible for reimbursement of to & fro Sleeper Class rail fare by shortest route on production of rail/bus tickets. SC/ST candidates called for interview for the post code II to V from outstations are not eligible for reimbursement of rail/bus fare if they are working under any Central/State Govt./Public Sector undertakings/Corporations/Local govt./Panchayats etc.
5. Candidates selected against this advertisement are likely to be posted at Indore but they are liable to serve in any of the constituent units of the Department of Atomic Energy in India.
